

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONEWAGO, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF CONEWAGO CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING A THIRTY-FIVE (35) MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON MILL ROAD LYING WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF CONEWAGO.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Conewago, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, as follow:

SECTION 1 Chapter 15, Motor Vehicle and Traffic, Part 2 Traffic Regulations, §201, Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets, is hereby revised, as follows:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Mill Road	Deodate Road (LR22009) on the north to Hill Road (T-303) on the south, on both sides thereof	35 MPH

SECTION 2. This revision is adopted pursuant to Pennsylvania Consolidated States Annotated, 75 Pa. C.S.A. §3362, §3363, §6109 (a) (10), §6109(b)(1), and §6109(e), based on Engineering and traffic Study completed pursuant to Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Publication 201.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED this 14th day of June,2008 to be effective five (5) days after enactment.
