

ORDINANCE NO. 98-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONEWAGO, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF CONEWAGO CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY ESTABLISHING A THIRTY-FIVE (35 MPH) MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON A PORTION OF MAPLEDALE ROAD..

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Conewago, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED. Pursuant to Section 6109(a)(10), Section 6109(b)(1), Section 6109(e), and Section 3363 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, as set forth in Title 75 of Purdon's Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, the Township of Conewago Code of Ordinances adopted by Ordinance No. 1997-1, as set forth in Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 201, "Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets", in Subsection 1 thereof, is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

| Mapledale Road (T-570) | Colebrook Road (SR-0341) to Valley Road (T-303), on both sides thereof. | 35 MPH |

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY. Those portions of Mapledale Road upon which these restrictions are being imposed have been the subject of an Engineering & Traffic Study completed pursuant to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Publication 201 and Section 6109(e) of the Vehicle Code, which determined that a thirty-five (35 MPH) mile per hour maximum restricted speed limit was warranted as the safe maximum speed, and such limit is being established pursuant to Section 3363 of the Vehicle Code

SECTION 3. PENALTIES. The fine and penalty for the violation of the provision set forth herein shall be the penalty set forth in Subsection 2 of Section 1, Part 2, Chapter 15 of the Township of Conewago Code of Ordinances.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into law this 11th day of November, 1998, to become effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
